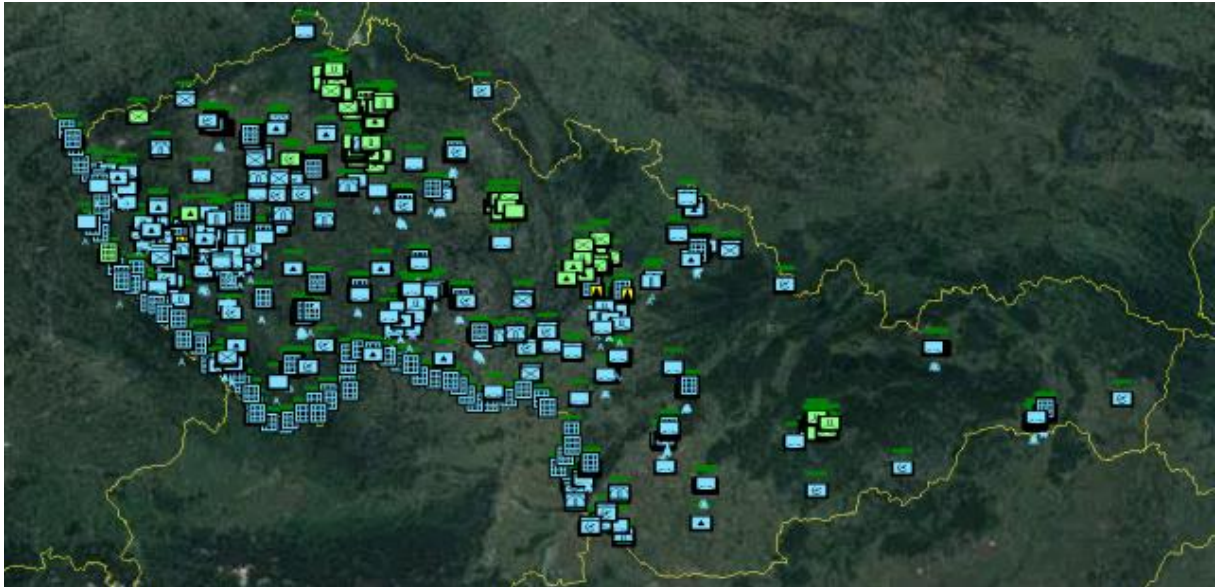


Czechoslovakia

Air defense forces

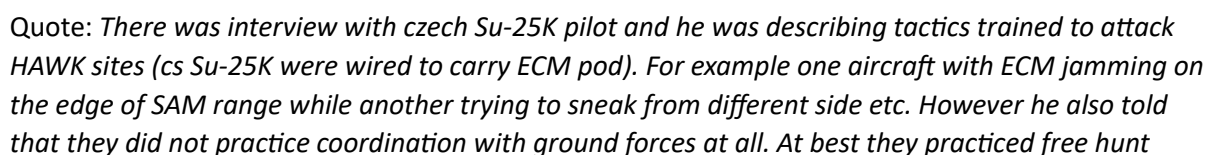
Air defense was a job for SAMs and Fighters and these were in the same organization. The ground attackers were attached to the Ground Forces and Frontline Aviation.
